

Knowledge Examinations (All Classes)

Examination Information:

- You are required to answer 25 of the 30 multiple-choice, computer-based questions correctly in order to be successful.
- While there is no specified time limit, examinations on average take 20-35 minutes to complete.
- The use of any reference material is not permitted. (Exception: a paper-based dictionary may be used but will be closely verified by Registry Agent Specialist)
- No electronic devices or cell phones may be used during the examination. They are required to be turned off or placed on vibrate as not to disturb other testees.
- In the event of an unsuccessful attempt, re-testing can occur as early as the next business day - the testing system will only allow one test per day.
- Following successful completion of the knowledge examination, vision screening will be required for all licence classes.

- If you are under the age of 18, a parent or legal guardian (guardianship documentation required) will need to initially accompany the testee to sign for consent.
Please note: Once the written consent has been issued from our office, the minor can re-test on his/her own with the consent form and acceptable identification.

- Currently, the knowledge exam for Class 7 licence is available in 10 languages: Arabic; Chinese (Traditional); English; Farsi; French; Hindi; Punjabi; Spanish; Tagalog (Philippines); and Vietnamese.
